

LOCAL LAW NO. 12-2012

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND SECTION 21-22.4 OF THE NASSAU COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE IN RELATION TO THE FEES CHARGED FOR THE REGISTRATION OF AUTOMATED TELLER MACHINES.

Passed by the Nassau County Legislature on August 6, 2012 Voting: ayes: 10 nayes: 9 abstained: 0

Became a law on August 8, 2012 with the approvel of the Deputy County Executive acting on behalf of the County Executive.



- Section 1. Subdivision II of Section 21-22.4(d) of the Nassau County Administrative Code, as amended by Local Law 2-2005, is amended to read as follows:
- (ii) The following fees shall be paid to the Commissioner, or agent, upon the registration or the renewal of a registration of an automated teller machine in accordance with the provisions of this title: for the initial registration by the operator of any automated teller machine in Nassau County, one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150); for each renewal of such registration after the initial registration of such machine, one hundred dollars (\$100).

- § 2. It is hereby determined, pursuant to the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act, 8 N.Y.E.C.L. section 0101 et seq. and its implementing regulations, Part 617 of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and Section 1611 of the County Government Law of Nassau County, that the adoption of this ordinance is a "Type II" Action within the meaning of Section 617.5(c)(20) and (27) of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and, accordingly, is of a class of actions which do not have a significant effect on the environment; and no further review is required.
 - \S 3. This local law shall take effect immediately.
