WHEREAS the District Attorney has previously established an Early Case Assessment Bureau (ECAB), within the Office of the District Attorney to receive criminal complaints that are instituted by police officers within the County; and

WHEREAS Assistant District Attorneys assigned to ECAB are required to work evenings, nights, weekends and holidays in addition to their usual weekday schedules;

WHEREAS the District Attorney wishes to encourage additional Assistant District Attorneys to devote additional shifts to ECAB to address the increased case volume and to maintain accessibility to the Office of the District Attorney at all times for victims and law enforcement; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED, by the County Legislature of the County of Nassau as follows::

Section 1. Subsection 3.5 of Ordinance No. 543-1995, as such Ordinance has been amended by Ordinance No. 26-1998, Ordinance No. 243-1999, Ordinance No. 46-c-2000, Ordinance No. 126-a-2000; and Ordinance No. 4-2002, is amended designating the first undesignated subdivision of subsection 3.5 as subdivision 1 and by amending subdivision 2 to subsection 3.5 to read as follows:

2. Assistant District Attorneys may receive hourly payment for additional time worked in

the Early Case Assessment Bureau (ECAB) in excess of their regularly scheduled full-time work week. Such hourly payment shall be calculated in accordance with the following two tiers as designated below:

## Tier One constitutes the following hours:

- a) 6:00pm to Midnight Monday through Friday; and
- b) 9:00am to Midnight on Saturdays and Sundays; and

# Tier Two constitutes the following hours:

- a) Midnight to 9:00am every night of the week; and
- b) All County Holidays

During Tier One hours, ADAs are to be paid at a rate of \$42.00 per hour.

During Tier Two hours, ADAs are to be paid at a rate of \$50.00 per hour.

### PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 49-2016

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 76-2000 RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF VARIOUS FEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

WHEREAS, the County desires to clarify the appropriate fee schedule to be applied when the County has entered into a contract of sale of real property to a not-for-profit organization prior to a change in the fee schedule and where the County had knowledge that the not-for-profit organization intended to construct a building for the public benefit, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED, by the County Legislature of the County of Nassau as follows:

Section 1: Section 8 of Ordinance No. 76-2000, relating to the establishment of various fees for the Department of Public Works, as last amended by Ordinance No. 176-2015, is amended as follows:

8. The Commissioner of Public Works is hereby authorized to charge a fee of One Thousand Five Hundred dollars (\$1,500) to review applications for building permits pursuant to Section 239-f of the General Municipal Law that are forwarded by the various towns, cities and incorporated villages. The fee shall be waived for an application filed where the anticipated cost of construction is less than twenty five thousand dollars (\$25,000). A fee of Seven Hundred and Forty dollars (\$740) shall be charged for a re-review of a previously rejected application for which a fee was required. If an application is made for a parcel that differs from the prior proposed use, a fee of seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750) shall be charged. If the value of construction estimate is greater than two hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) and is not a major subdivision defined by \$334a of the Real Property Law in addition to the base initial fee of One Thousand Five Hundred dollars (\$1,500) the applicant will be required

to pay three quarters of a percent (.75%) of the estimated construction value.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, any fees due and owed by a not-for-profit organization for any review of applications for building permits pursuant to this subdivision related to any parcel of real property sold to said not-for-profit by the County, shall be limited to such fees in effect on the date the County Legislature approved the contract of sale of such County real property to such not-for-profit organization, provided such approval date occurred after 2014.

BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A CAPITAL EXPENDITURE TO FINANCE THE CAPITAL PROJECTS SPECIFIED HEREIN WITHIN THE COUNTY OF NASSAU, AUTHORIZING \$11,600,000 OF BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF NASSAU TO FINANCE SAID EXPENDITURE, AND MAKING CERTAIN DETERMINATIONS PURSUANT TO THE STATE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW ACT, PURSUANT TO THE LOCAL FINANCE LAW OF NEW YORK AND THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT LAW OF NASSAU COUNTY.

WHEREAS, this bond ordinance is necessary to authorize bonds for the purpose of funding projects contemplated by capital budgets as provided in Section 310 of the County Government Law of Nassau County; and

WHEREAS, all necessary Federal, State, County and local permits, approvals and determinations of environmental impact for the purpose or purposes hereinafter referred to have been obtained or will have been obtained prior to the expenditure of proceeds of obligations to be authorized pursuant to this ordinance; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of the County of Nassau as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby determined pursuant to the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), 8 N.Y.E.C.L. section 0101 *et seq.* and its implementing regulations, Part 617 of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and Section 1611 of the County Government Law of Nassau County that each Project identified on Appendix A attached hereto and incorporated herein as "Type II" under the heading "SEQRA Determination" is a "Type II Action" within the meaning of Section 617.5(c) of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and, accordingly, is of a class of actions which do not have a significant effect on the environment and no further review is required. It is further hereby determined pursuant to the provisions of SEQRA, Part 617 of 6 N.Y.C.R.R. and Section 1611 of the County Government Law of Nassau County that each Project identified as an "Unlisted" under the heading "SEQRA Determination" on Appendix A attached hereto and incorporated herein, has been determined

not to have a significant effect on the environment. A record of each such determination shall be maintained in a file, readily accessible to the public, at the office of the Clerk of the Legislature.

Section 2. A capital expenditure for financing the cost of the objects or purposes identified under the heading "Project" on Appendix A attached hereto and incorporated herein, in the County of Nassau, is hereby authorized upon recommendation of the County Executive and by a two-thirds vote of the voting strength of the County Legislature, the amount of such capital expenditure to be \$11,600,000, which shall be financed with the proceeds from the issuance of \$11,600,000 of bonds.

Section 3. The County of Nassau (the "County") may issue its bonds in the aggregate principal amount of \$11,600,000 pursuant to the Local Finance Law of New York (the "LFL" or "Law") in order to finance the specific objects or purposes or classes of objects or purposes (hereinafter referred to as the "Purpose") described in Section 2 hereof.

Section 4. The County Legislature has determined and hereby states that the estimated aggregate maximum cost of such Purpose, including preliminary costs and costs incidental thereto and the financing thereof, is \$11,600,000. The maximum estimated cost of each component Project of the Purpose is set forth under the heading "Amount" on Appendix A attached hereto. Each project amount listed on said Appendix A is specific to that project and may not be shifted between projects(s) without thirteen affirmative votes. The plan of financing, as set forth in capital budgets and capital plans, includes \$11,600,000 to be raised by the issuance of bonds authorized by this ordinance, and the levy and collection of taxes on all the taxable real property of the County to pay the principal of said bonds and the interest thereon as the same shall become due and payable.

Section 5. The County Legislature hereby determines that the specific periods of probable usefulness (each, a "PPU") of each component Project of the Purpose for which said \$11,600,000 of bonds authorized pursuant to this ordinance are to be issued, within the limitations of the applicable subdivision of paragraph a. of Section 11.00 of the Law identified under the heading "PPU LFL Section(s)" on Appendix A attached hereto and incorporated herein, are identified under the heading "PPU" on said Appendix A. The County Executive is hereby authorized and directed to make any necessary or desirable changes on Appendix A hereto to conform it to the Capital Budget and Capital Plan approved concurrently herewith.

Section 6. Each of the bonds authorized by this ordinance and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds shall contain the recital of validity as prescribed by Section 52.00 of the Law and said bonds and any notes issued in anticipation of said bonds, shall be general obligations of the County, payable as to both principal and interest by general tax upon all the taxable real property within the County without limitation of rate or amount. The faith and credit of the County are hereby irrevocably pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on said bonds and any notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds and provision shall be made annually in the budget of the County by appropriation for (a) the amortization and redemption of said bonds and any notes issued in anticipation thereof to mature in such year and (b) the payment of interest to be due and payable in such year.

Section 7. Subject to the terms and conditions of this ordinance and the Law, and pursuant to the provisions of Section 21.00, Section 30.00, Section 50.00, Sections 56.00 to 60.00 and Section 63.00 of the Law, the powers and duties of the County Legislature relative to authorizing bond anticipation notes and the renewals thereof, determining whether to issue bonds with substantially level or declining annual debt service, prescribing the terms, form and contents of the bonds herein authorized, bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of said bonds and the renewals thereof, and any other powers or duties pertaining to or incidental to the sale and issuance of the bonds herein authorized and of any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of said bonds and the renewals thereof, are hereby delegated to the County Treasurer, the chief fiscal officer of the County.

Section 8. The County Treasurer is hereby authorized to cause such bonds and/or bond anticipation notes to be printed and to do such things as may be necessary to provide for the sale of such bonds and/or bond anticipation notes and to employ bond counsel to furnish to the purchaser or purchasers of such obligations an opinion as to their legality.

Section 9. The validity of any County bonds authorized by this ordinance and any County bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds, may be contested only if:

- (a) such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which the County is not authorized to expend money, or
- (b) the provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of the publication of this ordinance, or summary thereof, are not substantially

complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity, is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication; or

(c) such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the constitution of the State of New York.

Section 10. This ordinance shall constitute a statement of official intent for purposes of Treasury Regulations Section 1.150-2. Other than as set forth in this ordinance, no monies are, or are reasonably expected to be, reserved, allocated on a long-term basis, or otherwise set aside with respect to the permanent funding of the objects or purposes described herein.

Section 11. The Clerk of the County Legislature is hereby directed to publish this ordinance in full, or a summary thereof, together with a notice in substantially the form prescribed by Section 81.00 of the Law in the official newspaper of the County.

§ 12. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of the County of Nassau as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby determined pursuant to the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), 8 N.Y.E.C.L. section 0101 *et seq.* and its implementing regulations, Part 617 of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and Section 1611 of the County Government Law of Nassau County that each Project identified on Appendix A attached hereto and incorporated herein as "Type II" under the heading "SEQRA Determination" is a "Type II Action" within the meaning of Section 617.5(c) of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and, accordingly, is of a class of actions which do not have a significant effect on the environment and no further review is required. It is further hereby determined pursuant to the provisions of SEQRA, Part 617 of 6 N.Y.C.R.R. and Section 1611 of the County Government Law of

Nassau County that each Project identified as an "Unlisted" under the heading "SEQRA Determination" on Appendix A attached hereto and incorporated herein, has been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment. The maximum estimated cost of each component Project of the Purpose is set forth under the heading "Amount" on Appendix A attached hereto. The County Legislature hereby determines that the specific periods of probable usefulness (each, a "PPU") of each component Project of the Purpose for which said \$3,000,000 of bonds authorized pursuant to this ordinance are to be issued, within the limitations of the applicable subdivision of paragraph a. of Section 11.00 of the Law identified under the heading "LFL" on Appendix A attached hereto and incorporated herein, are identified under the heading "PPU" on said Appendix A. The County Executive is

hereby authorized and directed to make any necessary or desirable changes on Appendix A hereto to conform it to the Capital Budget and Capital Plan approved concurrently herewith.

Section 6. Each of the bonds authorized by this ordinance and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds shall contain the recital of validity as prescribed by Section 52.00 of the Law and said bonds and any notes issued in anticipation of said bonds, shall be general obligations of the County, payable as to both principal and interest by general tax upon all the taxable real property within the County without limitation of rate or amount. The faith and credit of the County are hereby irrevocably pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on said bonds and any notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds and provision shall be made annually in the budget of the County by appropriation for (a) the amortization and redemption of said bonds and any notes issued in anticipation thereof to mature in such year and (b) the payment of interest to be due and payable in such year.

Section 7. Subject to the terms and conditions of this ordinance and the Law, and pursuant to the provisions of Section 21.00, Section 30.00, Section 50.00, Sections 56.00 to 60.00 and Section 63.00 of the Law, the powers and duties of the County Legislature relative to authorizing bond anticipation notes and the renewals thereof, determining whether to issue bonds with substantially level or declining annual debt service, prescribing the terms, form and contents of the bonds herein authorized, bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of said bonds and the renewals thereof, and any other powers or duties pertaining to or incidental to the sale and issuance of the bonds herein authorized and of any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of said bonds and the renewals thereof, are hereby delegated to the County Treasurer, the chief fiscal officer of the County.

Section 8. The County Treasurer is hereby authorized to cause such bonds and/or bond anticipation notes to be printed and to do such things as may be necessary to provide for the sale of such bonds and/or bond anticipation notes and to employ bond counsel to furnish to the purchaser or purchasers of such obligations an opinion as to their legality.

Section 9. The validity of any County bonds authorized by this ordinance and any County bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds, may be contested only if:

(a) such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which the County is not authorized to expend money, or

- (b) the provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of the publication of this ordinance, or summary thereof, are not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity, is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication; or
- (c) such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the constitution of the State of New York.

Section 10. This ordinance shall constitute a statement of official intent for purposes of Treasury Regulations Section 1.150-2. Other than as set forth in this ordinance, no monies are, or are reasonably expected to be, reserved, allocated on a long-term basis, or otherwise set aside with respect to the permanent funding of the objects or purposes described herein.

Section 11. The Clerk of the County Legislature is hereby directed to publish this ordinance in full, or a summary thereof, together with a notice in substantially the form prescribed by Section 81.00 of the Law in the official newspaper of the County.

§ 12. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

WHEREAS, on March 7, 2016, pursuant to Section 310 of the County Government Law of Nassau County, the Nassau County Legislature by Resolution No. 27-2016 approved and adopted the four-year Capital Plan for the County of Nassau for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2016 (the "Capital Plan"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 310 of such County Government Law, the County Executive may propose, at any time subsequent to the passage of the ordinance approving the Capital Budget, an ordinance to amend the Capital Budget; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive, based upon a review of the Capital Budget priorities by the Nassau County Department of Public Works, proposes that the amounts described herein be authorized in the Capital Budget for certain projects as hereinafter set forth in Appendix A attached hereto and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has solicited the recommendations of the Office of Management and Budget and the Office of Legislative Budget Review with respect to the amendment to the Capital Budget contained in this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive herein proposes changes as hereinafter described to the Capital Budget that provide for additional programs, projects or activities; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by County Legislature of the County of Nassau as follows:

Section 1. The Capital Budget, as adopted by Ordinance No. 13-2016, is amended as follows:

Section 2. It is hereby determined pursuant to the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), 8 N.Y.E.C.L. Section 0101 et seq. and its implementing regulations, Part 617 of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and Section 1611 of the County Government Law of Nassau County that each Project identified on Appendix B attached hereto, if any, and incorporated herein as "Type II", if any, under the heading "SEQRA" is a "Type II Action" within the meaning of Section 617.5(c) of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and, accordingly, is of a class of actions which do not have a significant effect on the environment and no further review is required. It is further hereby determined pursuant to the provisions of SEQRA, Part 617 of 6 N.Y.C.R.R. and Section 1611 of the County Government Law of Nassau County that each Project identified as "Type I" or "Unlisted" under the heading "SEQRA" on Appendix B attached hereto, if any, and incorporated herein, has been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment. A record of each such determination shall be maintained in a file, readily accessible to the public, at the office of the Clerk of the Legislature.

Section 3. This ordinance may be modified to allow for the correction of any mathematical and/or typographical errors subsequent to any approval and adoption of said ordinance without the necessity for a vote to be taken by the County Legislature or by the members of any Standing Committee of said Legislature if said ordinance is passed by the affirmative vote of a majority of said Legislature.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
