Narrative

Purpose:

The replacement of two (2) steam boilers, burners and control panels, and boiler room drainage improvements. The work also includes selective demolition, asbestos abatement, new floor drains and restoration of surfaces and finishes, as well as electrical work.

Discussion:

A total of three (3) firms bid. The contract was publicly bid in accordance with General Municipal Law 103. ACS System Associates, Inc. was the lowest responsible bidder with a base bid in the amount of \$1,602,000.00 and a bid for Alternate No. 1 in the amount of \$397,000 for a total of \$1,999,000.00.

Impact on Funding:

The contract provides for the expenditure of \$1,999,000.00. Bids were opened on October 13, 2015. The lowest responsible bidder, ACS System Associates, Inc. has provided the County with a bid proposal which meets the Departments requirements. Funds for this contract are available in Capital Project No. 90611.

Note 1 - Organization and Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

a. Nature of Business

ACS System Associates, Inc. (the Company), is a contractor organized in New York on December 29, 1983, doing business in New York City's five boroughs, Long Island, and Westchester County with its main office located in Westchester County. The principal services of the Company consist of heating, ventilation, and air conditioning work. The work is typically performed under fixed price, unit price, and time and material contracts. The length of the Company's contracts varies, but is typically less than three years.

b. Method of Accounting for Income from Construction Contracts

Income from long-term construction contracts is recognized under the percentage-of-completion method. Under this method estimated profit to be earned upon completion of a contract is recognized in the proportion that direct costs incurred to date bears to estimated total costs to complete the contract. Cost and profit estimates are subject to revision as contracts extend over one or more periods, and any required adjustments are made in the period in which the revisions become known. Provisions are made for the full amount of anticipated losses in the period in which they are first determinable. Revenues earned from time and material contracts are recognized on the basis of costs incurred during the period plus the fee earned, measured by the cost-to-cost method.

The asset, "Costs and estimated earnings in excess of billings on contracts in progress", represents revenue recognized in excess of amounts billed. The liability, "Billings in excess of costs and estimated earnings on contracts in progress", represents billings in excess of revenues recognized.

c. Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

d. Balance Sheet Classification

In accordance with industry practice, the Company includes in current assets and liabilities amounts realizable and payable under long-term construction contracts even when such amounts are realizable or payable over a period in excess of one year.

e. Cash and Cash Equivalents

For purposes of the statements of cash flows, the Company considers all highly liquid debt instruments purchased with a maturity of three months or less to be cash equivalents.

f. Accounts Receivables and Bad Debts

Accounts receivable represent collectible current and retainage balances due from contracts. It is the Company's policy to evaluate the collectability of receivables and provide a reserve when deemed necessary. The total allowance for doubtful accounts as of December 31, 2014 and 2013 was \$260,000 each year.

g. Inventory

Inventory consists of construction materials and is reported at the lower of cost or market.

h. Property and Equipment

Property and equipment are recorded at cost and items are depreciated under the straight-line method. Depreciation is provided in amounts sufficient to write off the cost of depreciable assets, less salvage value, over their estimated useful lives.

i. Income Taxes

The Company accounts for income taxes in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. A current or deferred tax liability or benefit is recognized for current or deferred tax effects of all events recognized in the financial statements. Those effects are measured based on provisions of current tax law to determine the amount of taxes payable or refundable currently or in future years. The tax effects of earning income or incurring expenses in future years or the future enactment of a change in tax laws or taxes are not anticipated in determining deferred tax benefits or liability. Deferred income taxes result primarily from depreciation expense, accounts receivable allowance, and timing differences in the reporting of revenues and expenses for income tax and financial statement purposes.

The Company, with the consent of their stockholder, has elected under the Internal Revenue Code, New Jersey, and New York Tax Code to be an S Corporation. In lieu of corporate federal, New Jersey, and New York income taxes, the elockholder of an S Corporation is taxed on their proportionate share of the Company's taxable income. Therefore, no provision or liability for federal, New Jersey, or New York State Income taxes has been included in these financial statements, with the exception of any minimum taxes due. New York City does not recognize S Corporations, therefore city income taxes are provided at a rate of 8.85%.

Management evaluated the Company's tax positions and concluded that the Company has taken no uncertain tax positions that require adjustment to the financial statements to comply with the provisions of this guidance.

Generally, the Company is subject to income tax examinations by major taxing authorities during the three year period prior to the period covered by these financial statements.

j. Pending Pronouncements

In May 2014, the Financial Accounting Standards Board (FASB) issued ASU 2014-09, Revenue from Contracts with Customers, requiring an entity to recognize the amount of revenue to which it expects to be entitled for the transfer of promised goods or services to customers. The updated standard will replace most existing revenue recognition guidance in U.S. GAAP when it becomes effective and permits the use of either a full retrospective or retrospective with cumulative effect transition method. The updated standard will be effective for annual reporting periods beginning after December 15, 2017. The Company has not yet selected a transition method and is currently evaluating the effect the updated standard will have on the financial statements.

k. Evaluation of Subsequent Events

The Company evaluated subsequent events for potential recognition or disclosure through March 16, 2015, the date the financial statements were available to be issued.
