Narrative

Purpose:

The principal features of the work under this Contract include: Furnish all labor, materials and equipment required for all work (General Construction, Mechanical Construction, Electrical Construction, and Plumbing Construction) associated with the construction of a new+/- 13,300 sq. ft., one (1) story and mezzanine, pre-engineered-type, steel framed Police Department Garage Building with standby generator, and associated site improvements, make complete and ready for operation. This project shall be administrated under a Project Labor Agreement.

Discussion:

Four (4) firms submitted bids. J. Anthony Enterprises, Inc. was the apparent low bidder, with a cost 7.9 % above the Engineer's Estimate.

Impact on Funding:

The contract provides for the expenditure of \$5,746,000.00. Bids were opened on April 12, 2016. The lowest responsible bidder, J. Anthony Enterprises, Inc. has provided the County with a bid proposal which meets the Departments requirements. Funding will be provided thru Capital Project No. B50680.

Recommendation:

The Department recommends this contract be approved as submitted.




