Narrative

Purpose: This contract consists of the rehabilitation of the various concrete members of the Pearl Street Bridge over Mill River in Oceanside. The work includes removal and replacement of deteriorated concrete, repair of joints, replacement of pavement markings and traffic loops, clearing and grubbing, as well as other incidental work.

Procurement history, if applicable: Project was bid, and it is recommended to award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder, Thomas Novelli Contracting who had the successful low bid of \$1,357,575.00. A total of four (4) firms bid on this contract, and all were deemed to be local contractors.




