

PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 182- 2016

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS OF THE
COUNTY OF NASSAU TO DISPOSE OF OBSOLETE LEVER VOTING MACHINES**

WHEREAS, the Nassau County Board of Elections is in possession of lever voting machines; and

WHEREAS, the lever voting machines have become obsolete in light of the passage of the New York Election Reform and Modernization Act which requires the use of electronic voting machines for elections; and

WHEREAS, the County has already disposed majority of the lever machines via public auction but still has a small amount of lever machines remaining; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Elections would like to dispose of the remaining lever voting machines in the most expeditious manner possible; now, therefore

BE IT ORDINAINED by the Nassau County Legislature as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Elections of the County of Nassau is hereby authorized to make its remaining lever voting machines available to any public (including special districts such as fire, sanitation and water districts) or private entity or person at a public auction or for individual sale at a price that the Board of Elections deems appropriate or donating said machines to a museum or institution of primary, secondary or higher education for display or historical purposes.

§2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
