23 Item 505 of 2016, an ordinance supplemental
24 to the annual appropriation ordinance in
25 connection with the Department of Public

4 LEGISLATOR MACKENZIE: Second.

5 CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: Motion by
6 Mr. Rhoads, seconded by Mr. MacKenzie. The
7 item is before us.

8 MR. ARNOLD: Ken Arnold, Public
9 Works. Item 505 is a supplemental
10 appropriation associated with the
11 Department's UPW fee grant program. This
12 grant program is where the department
13 receives funding to assist New York State
14 Regional Transportation planning activities.

15 CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: And the
16 money will go to what program?

17 MR. ARNOLD: It's funding that
18 goes to our salary line and contractual
19 services. It helps the department assist
20 the state in regional transportation
21 planning, we sit on various committees,
22 subcommittees. We work on developing the
23 tip, where we get funding for resurfacing
24 and West Shore Road and other projects that
25 we come forward to you on.

2 CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: How much is
3 this funding?

4 MR. ARNOLD: For \$312,000.

5 CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: Any other
6 questions? Ms. Curran.

7 LEGISLATOR CURRAN: Hello. So,
8 according to the backup -- and correct me if
9 I'm wrong in any of this -- Nassau's total
10 budgeted amount is about \$909,000 made up of
11 this \$312,000 with a local match of \$78,000.
12 And, also, unspent "prior year funds" of
13 about \$518,000?

14 MR. ARNOLD: That's correct.

15 LEGISLATOR CURRAN: So what is
16 this in unspent funds?

17 MR. ARNOLD: That is various
18 funding that the county did not utilize yet.
19 We are currently working with our new
20 director of traffic engineering to put
21 together a plan to utilize this funding on
22 different projects.

23 LEGISLATOR CURRAN: So, if we had
24 spent it all, would we be getting more now
25 through the state grant?

2 MR. ARNOLD: No, we would not.

3 LEGISLATOR CURRAN: Thank you.

4 CHAIRMAN MUSCARELLA: Any other
