Contract Summary

Purpose: 2017 Resurfacing Requirements Contract in the Towns of Hempstead, North Hempstead & Oyster Bay & in the Cities of Glen Cove & Long Beach

The work to be performed under this contract includes furnishing labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals as specified for the resurfacing of asphalt and concrete surfaces and other related work at various locations to be selected during a twenty-four month (24) period.

Method of Procurement: The contractor was selected through an open competitive bidding process.

Procurement History: On April 11, 2017, sealed bids were received by the Clerk of the Nassau County Legislature. Bids were publicly opened and read aloud in the Meeting Room of the Nassau County Legislature. A total of two (2) firms bid on this contract and it is recommended to award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder, Carlo Lizza & Sons Paving, Inc. who had the low bid of \$776,500.00.

Description of General Provisions: This is a unit price contract.

Impact on Funding / Price Analysis: The bid price of \$776,500.00 is below the engineer's estimate of \$1,283,828.30 and is for comparison purposes only. This contract will include an annual cap of four million dollars (\$4,000,000.00). Funding being encumbered will come from approved and available funds from Capital Project Number 61587.






