

CONFLICT OF INTEREST:

1. As a bidder/purchaser of Nassau County, New York (the "County") tax liens, you shall disclose:
 - a. Any material financial relationships that you, your firm or any firm principal or employee has that may create a conflict of interest or the appearance of a conflict of interest in connection with the bid or purchase of County tax liens.
 - b. Any family relationships that you or any principal or employee of your firm has with any County officer, agent or employee that may create a conflict of interest or the appearance of a conflict of interest in connection with the bid or purchase of County tax liens.
 - c. Any other matter that you or your firm believes may create a conflict of interest or the appearance of a conflict of interest in connection with the bid or purchase of County tax liens.

CERTIFICATION:

A materially false statement or omission willfully or fraudulently made in connection with this registration may result in voiding any tax lien bids or purchases, and in addition may subject the person making the false statement to criminal charges and/or fines as provided by law.

I, _____, have read and understand the items contained above and Section 2203 of the Nassau County Charter; that I supplied full and complete answers to each item above to the best of my knowledge, information and belief; that I will notify the County in writing of any change in circumstances occurring after the submission of this certification and before the consummation of any tax lien purchases; and that all information supplied by me is true to the best of my knowledge, information and belief. § 2203. Pecuniary interest of officers, employee or agents in sales of tax liens or sales of property acquired by tax lien procedure or condemnation proceedings prohibited. Any officer or employee or agent of the county, whether he be such by election, appointment or contract, who directly or indirectly, either on his own behalf or for another person or corporation, except in his official capacity as a representative of the county, shall bid at or who shall be financially interested in a tax lien, sale or the sale or purchase of any tax lien certificate, or shall be financially interested in the public or private sale or purchase of any property acquired by the county as a result of any tax collection procedure, or who shall be financially interested in any condemnation proceeding to which the county or any subdivision thereof is a party shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall forfeit his office or employment or agency and shall be further punished by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars or by, imprisonment for not more than six months or both such fine and imprisonment. Any such sale or purchase of a tax lien or a tax lien certificate or of property or condemnation proceeding shall be voidable on the application of the Comptroller to a court of competent jurisdiction.
