Provides service at the passenger's request. Shared ride, curb to curb for those unable to use fixed route.

Serves the disabled with pre-approved application within ¾ mile of fixed bus route.

Provides scheduled trips to and from medical, therapy appointments for Medicaid consumers OR call your managed care plan.
Call to schedule 3 days prior.
