## LOCAL LAW NO. 10-2015

A LOCAL LAW TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING THE EFFECT OF LOCAL LAW 8-15.



Passed by the Nassau County Legislature on December 21, 2015 Voting: ayes: 17, nayes: 0, abstained: 0
Became a law on December 22, 2015 with the approval of the County Executive.

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Nassau, as follows:

Section 1. Local Law number 8-15, "A Local Law to Amend The Administrative Code Of Nassau County With Respect To Fees Charged By The Nassau County Clerk To Any Individual Who Presents Documents For Recording And Indexing or Satisfaction Or Cancellation of Claims and Liens," is hereby suspended until January 4, 2016.

- § 2. Any sums heretofore collected by the County pursuant to Local Law 8-15 shall be refunded to the payee.
- § 3. It is hereby determined, pursuant to the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act, 8 N.Y.E.C.L. section 0101 et seq. and its implementing regulations, Part 617 of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., that this is a "Type II" Actions within the meaning of Section 617.5(c)(20) of 6 N.Y.C.R.R. ("routine or continuing agency administration and

management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment"), and, accordingly, are of a class of actions which do not have a significant effect on the environment; and no further review is required.

§ 4. This local law shall take effect immediately
