- Training at United Way's E3 Career Training Center (Energy /Efficiency /Education), a state-of-the-art facility equipped with the latest technology and equipment to provide VetsBuild students with hands-on training.
- Basic training in weatherization and energy efficiency in the emerging Green Industry field. This includes a 10-hour entry-level OSHA training program.
- Once the introductory training has been completed, advanced training opportunities are available in heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC), composite technology and advanced manufacturing.
- Preparation for job opportunities in the high-growth, high-demand energy retrofit, weatherization, & green building industries.
- One-on-one job counseling and job placement assistance, soft skills training, resume workshops and interview preparation.
- VetsBuild graduates interested in a career in weatherization are provided information about advanced training options available through partner institutional providers.
- Building Performance Institute (BPI) test center – advance credentials available.
