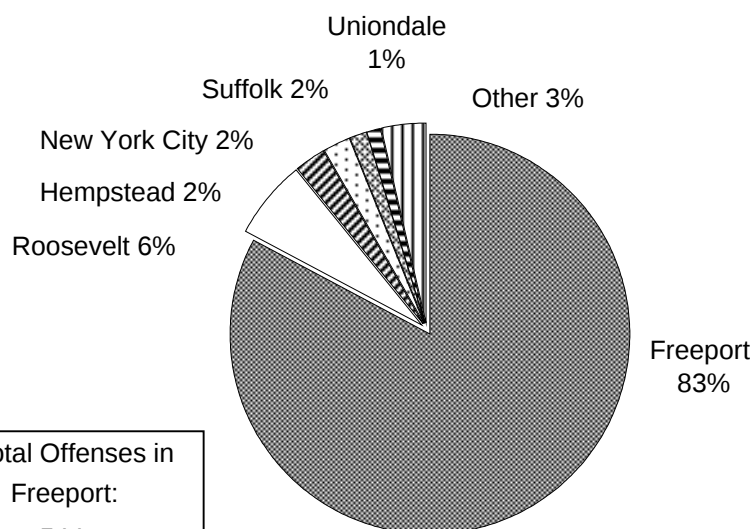

### 1997 YOUTH OFFENDERS IN FREEPORT: THE OFFENDERS' COMMUNITY OF RESIDENCE



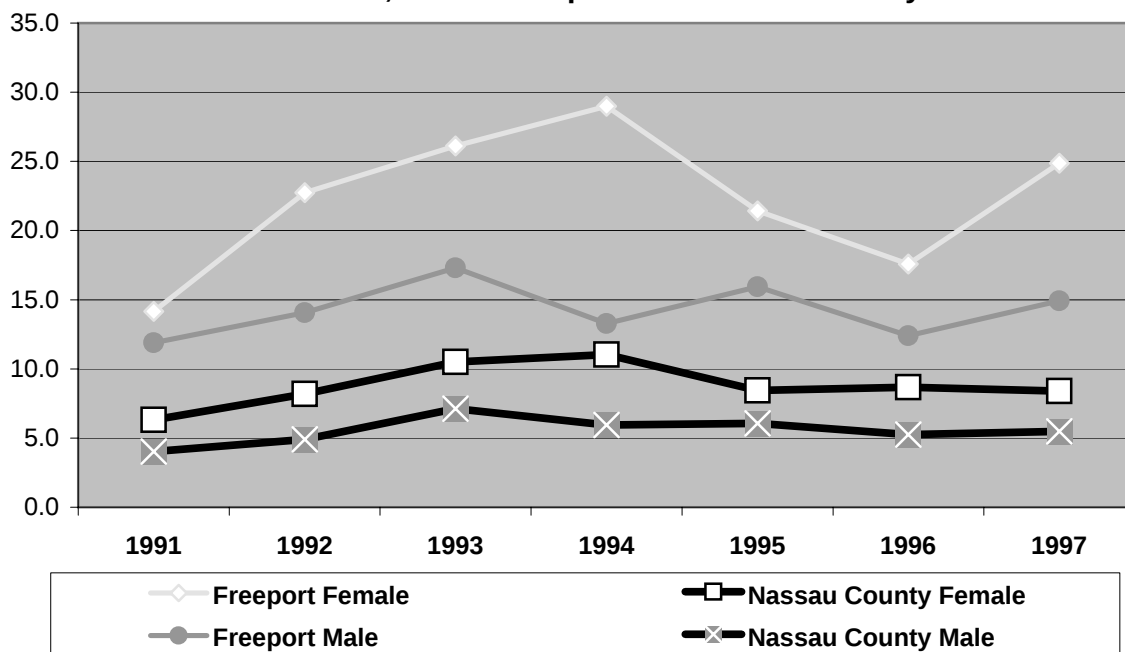

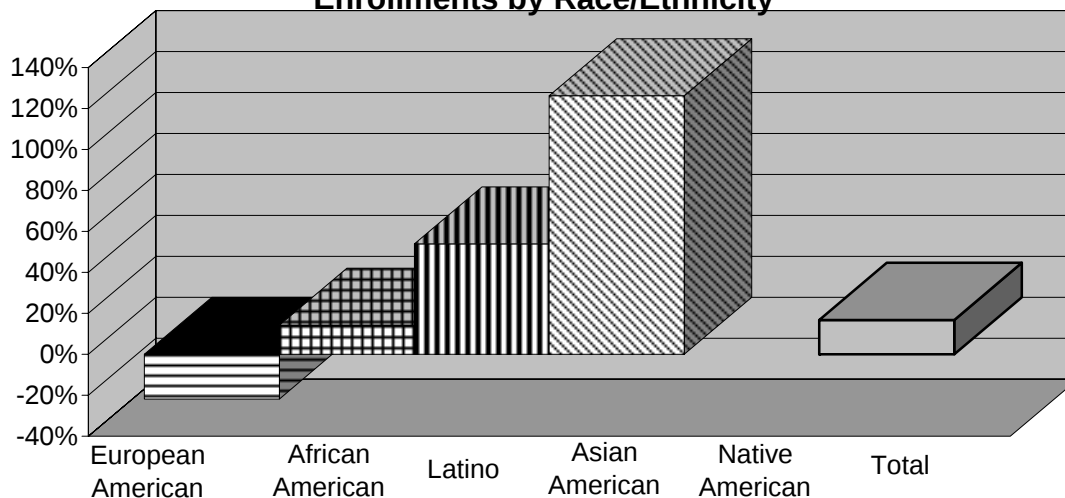

Enrollments by Race/Ethnicity**

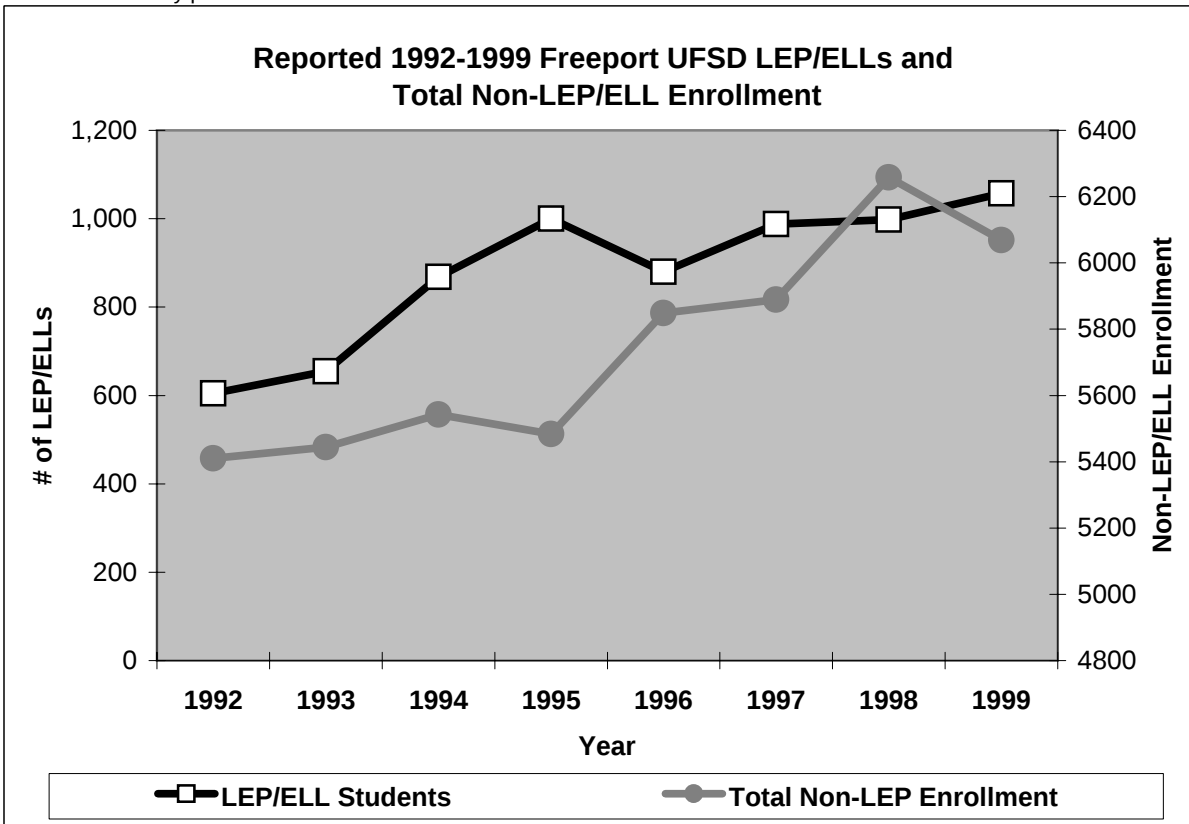

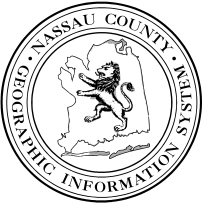
HISPANIC/LATINO POPULATION

Population by Census Blocks

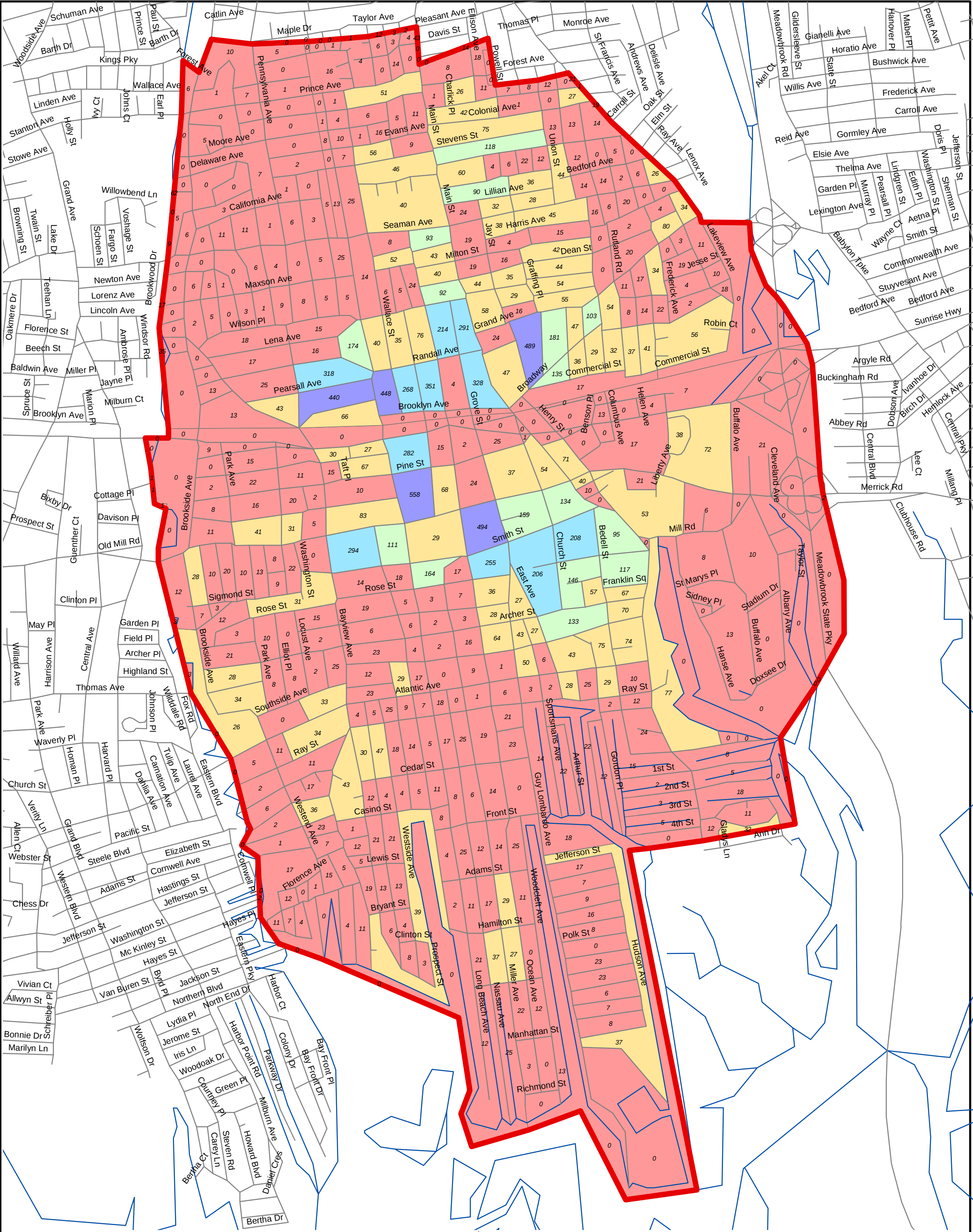

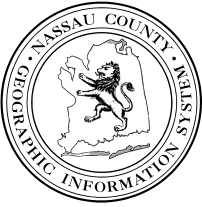
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# Community Profile for the Zip-Code Community of Freeport
