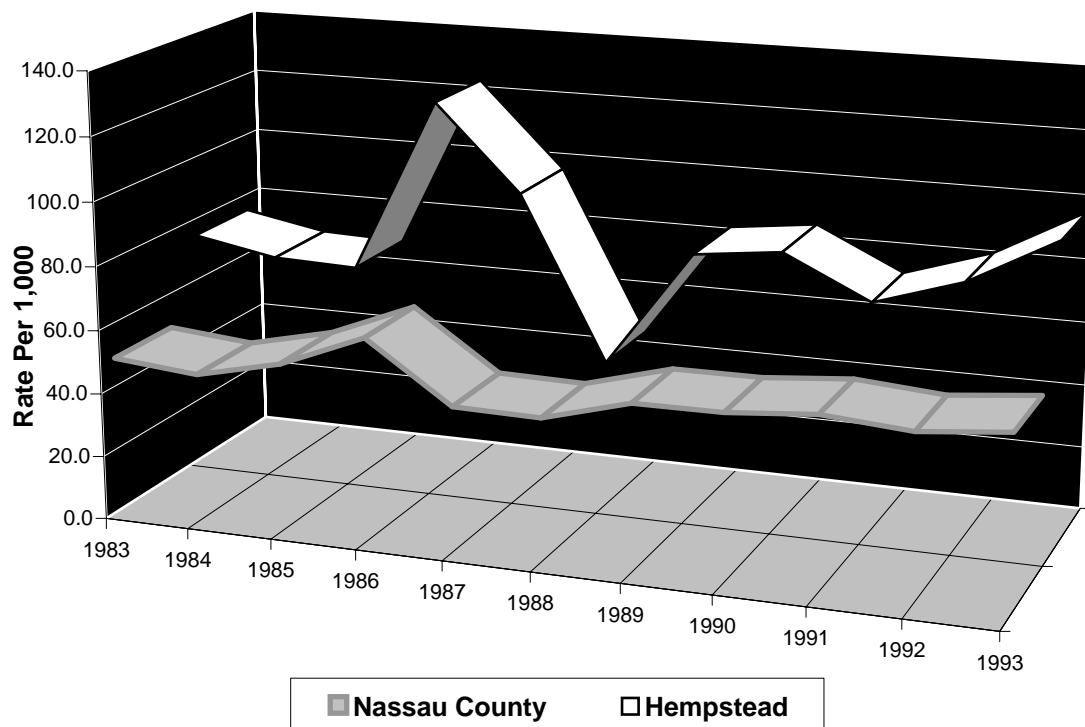

Per 1,000: 1983-1993**

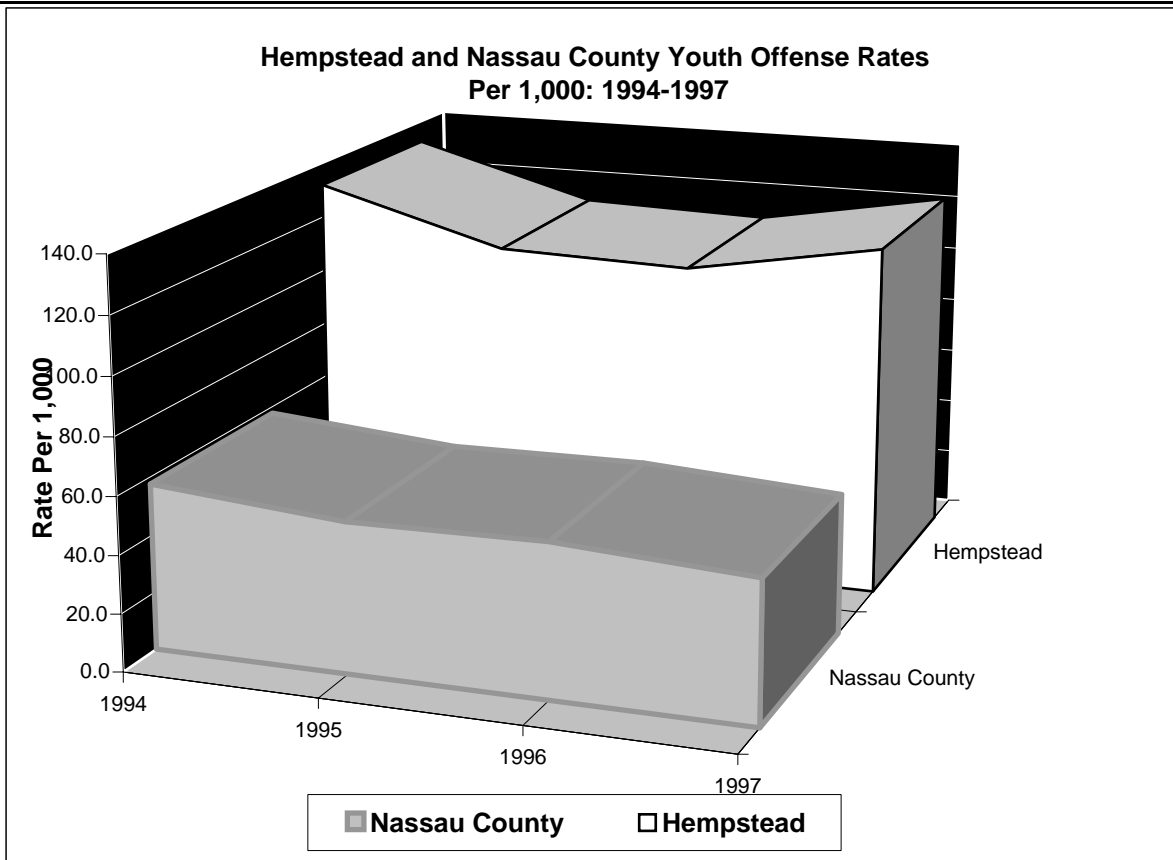

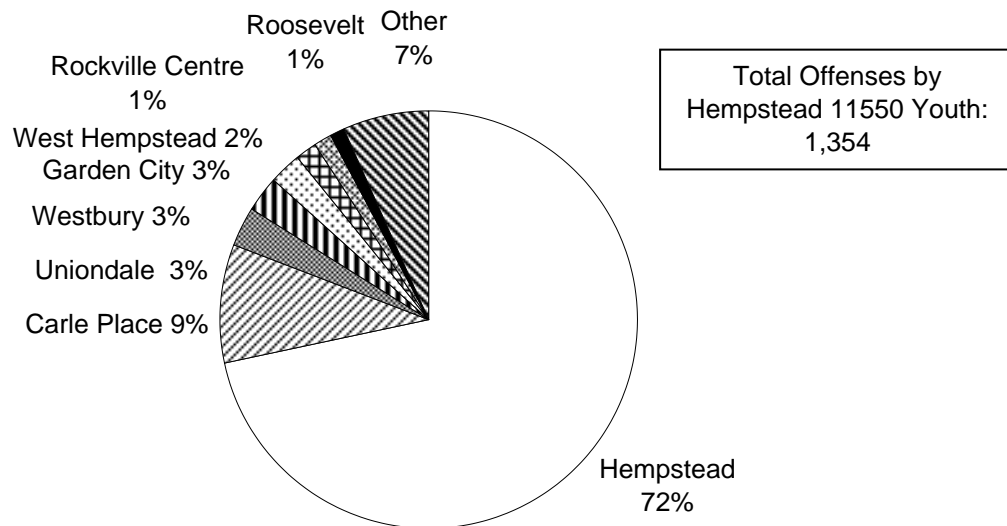

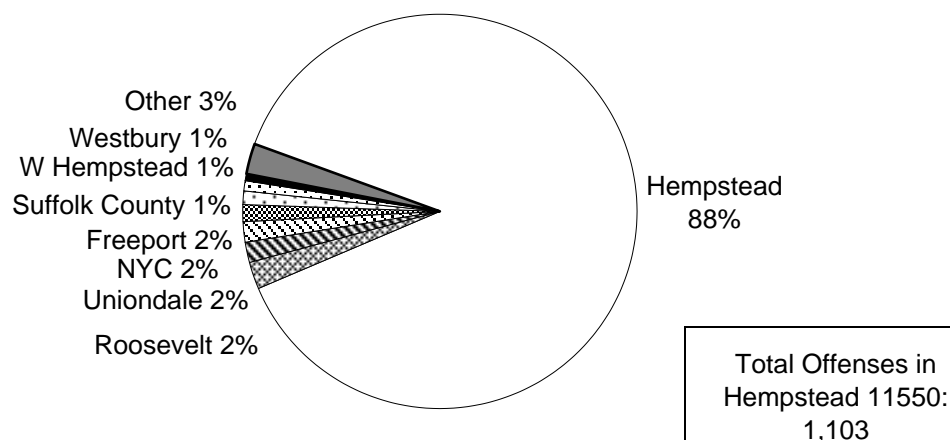

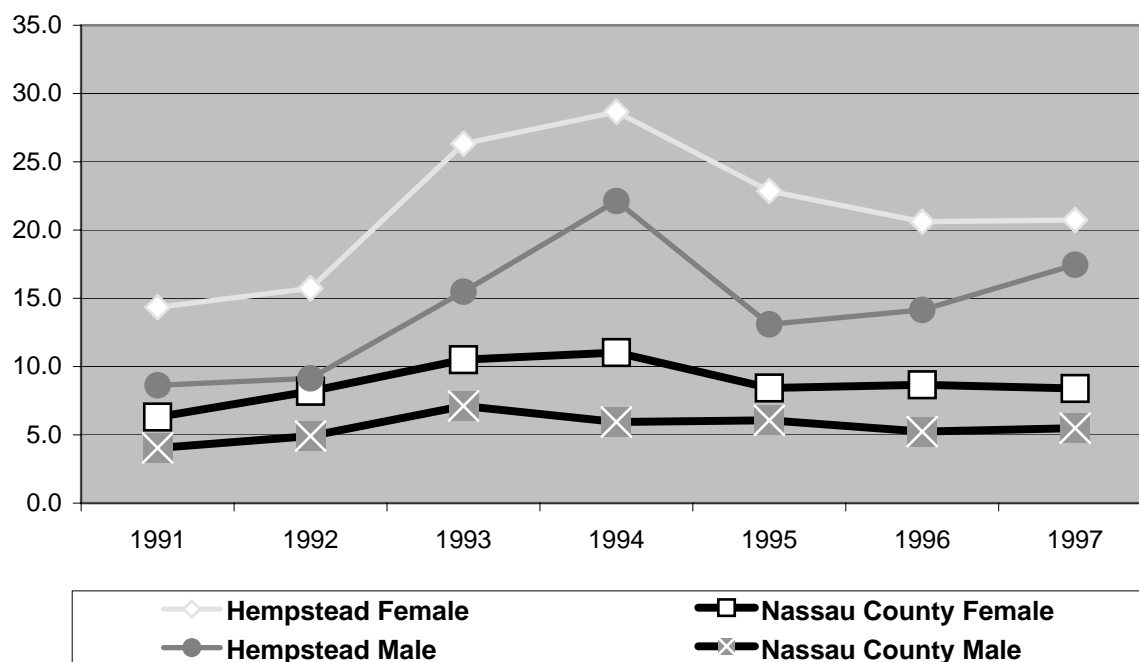

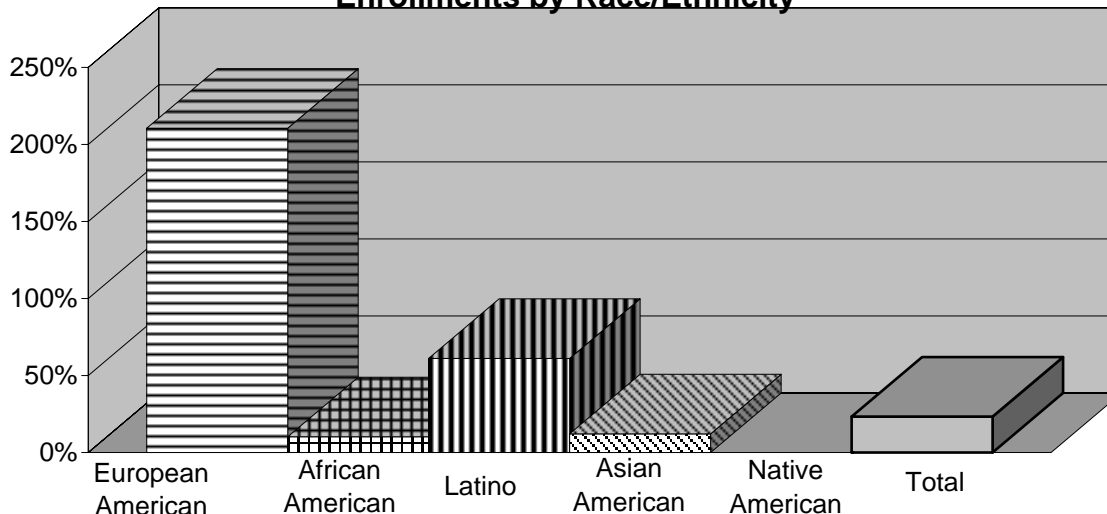

Enrollments by Race/Ethnicity**

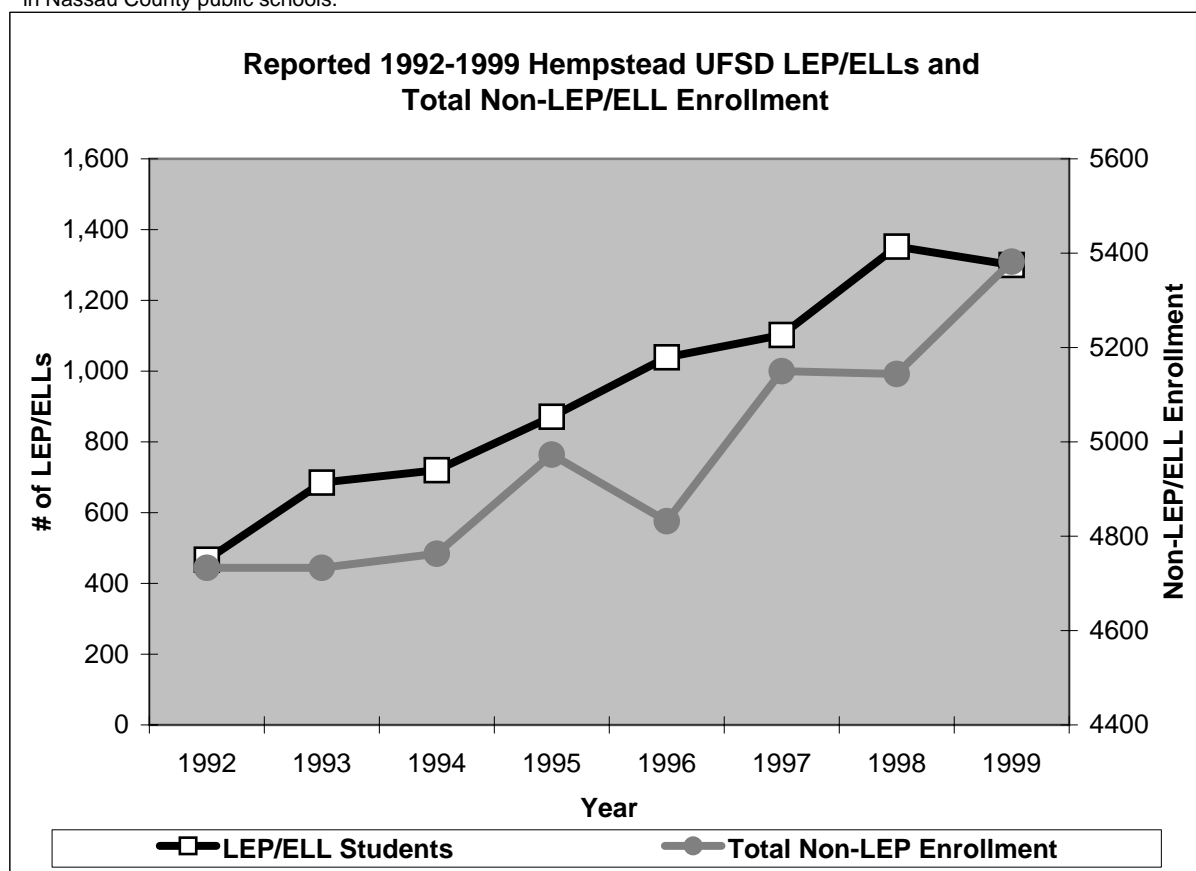

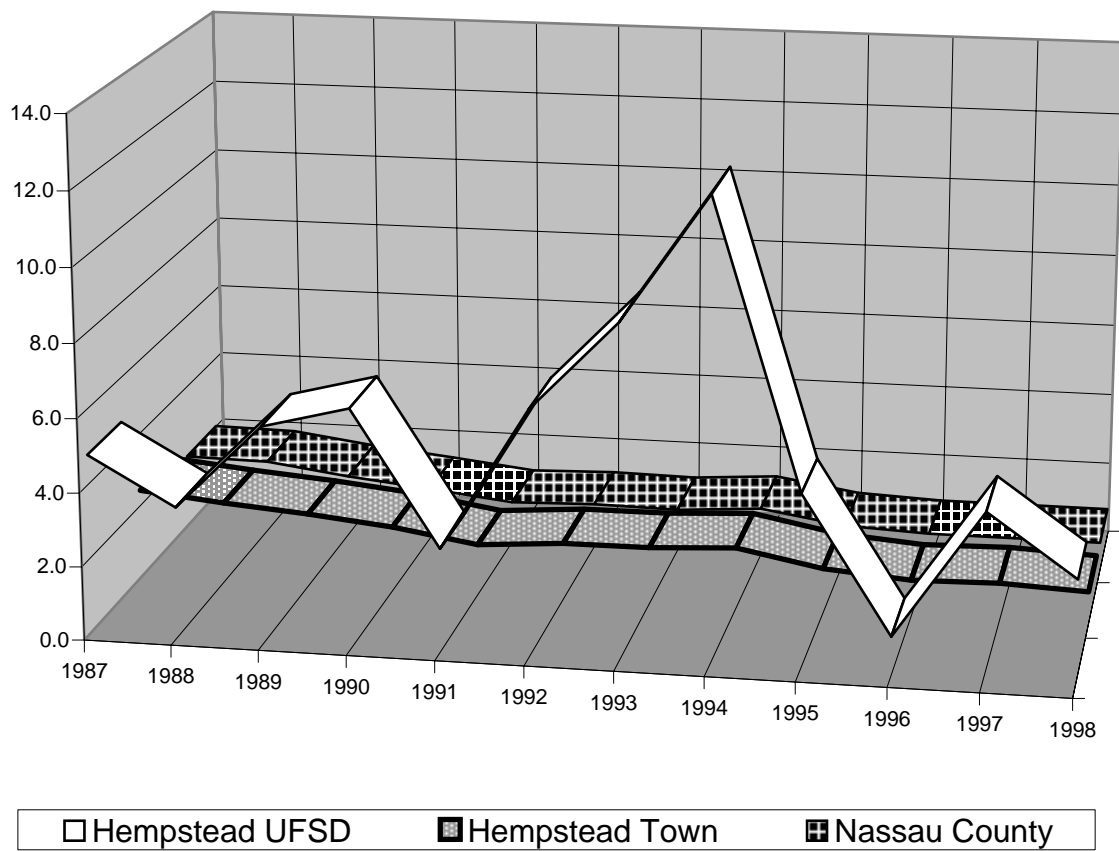

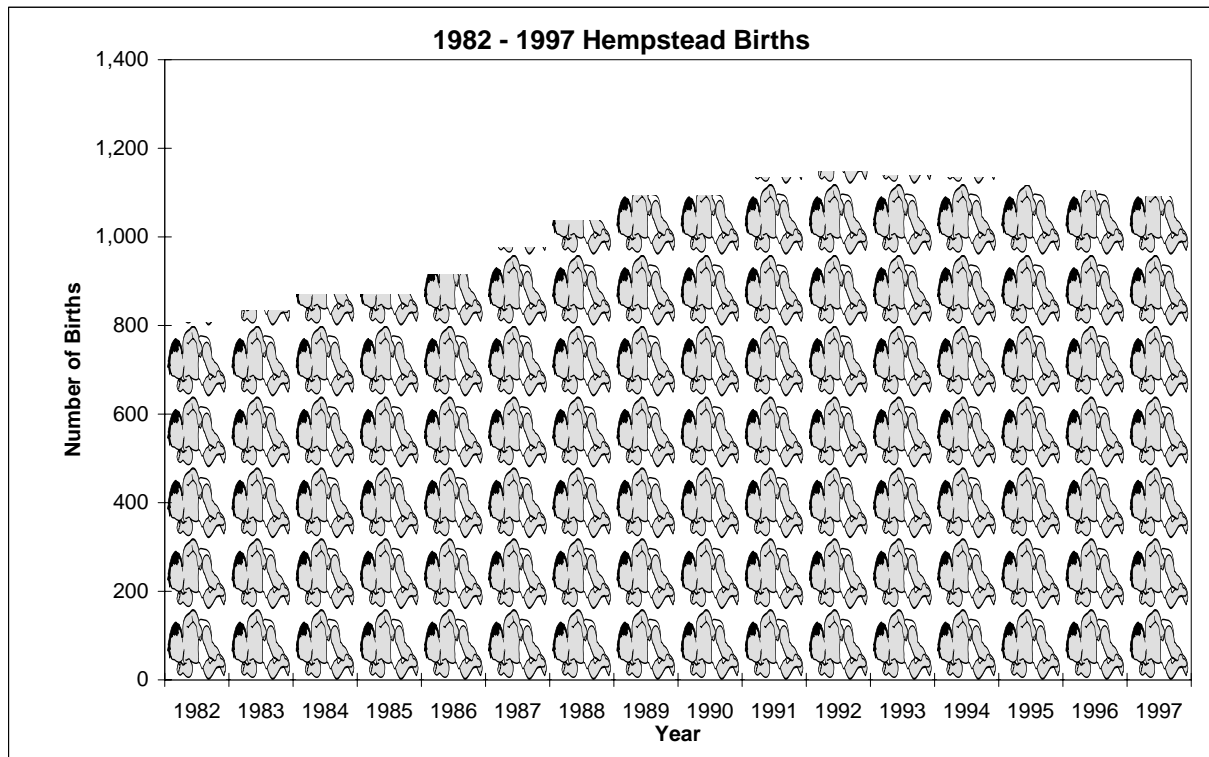
**1987-98 HIGH SCHOOL DROPOUT PERCENTS IN HEMPSTEAD UFSD,

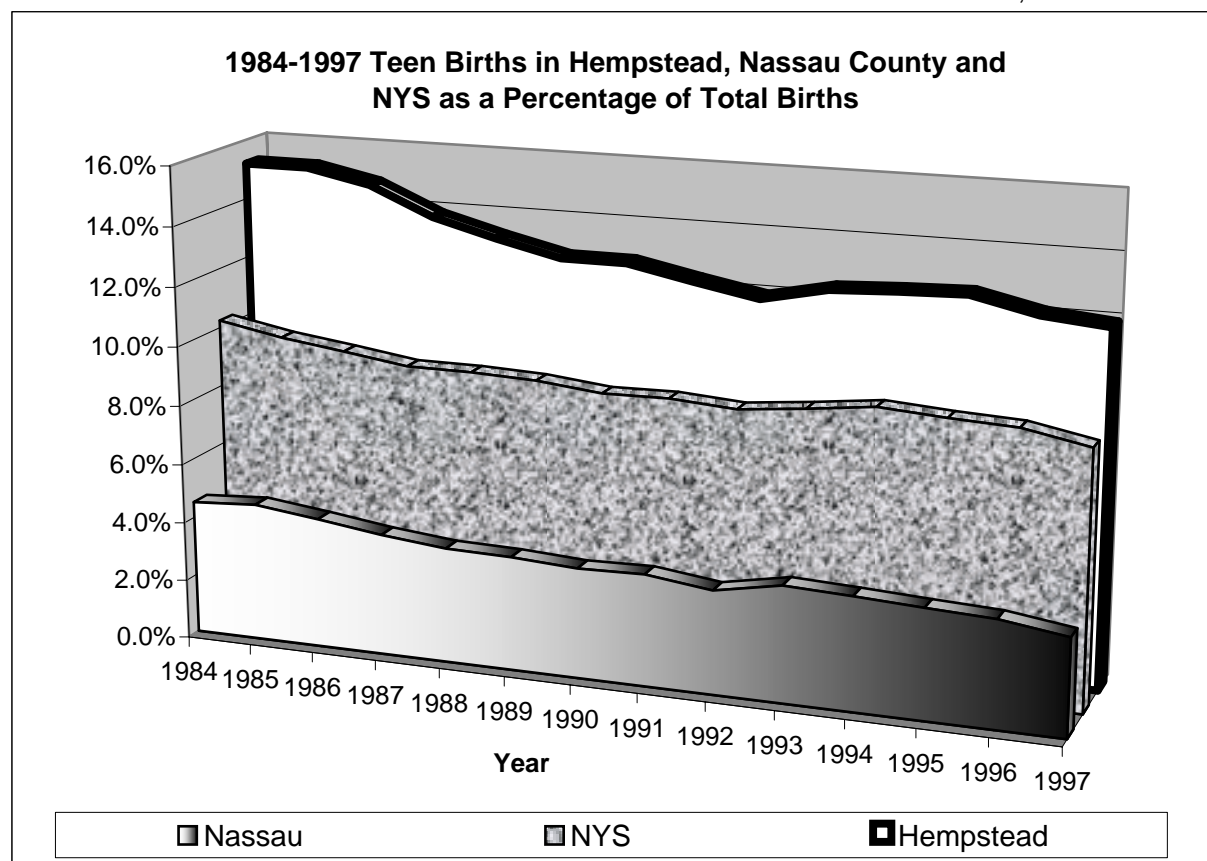

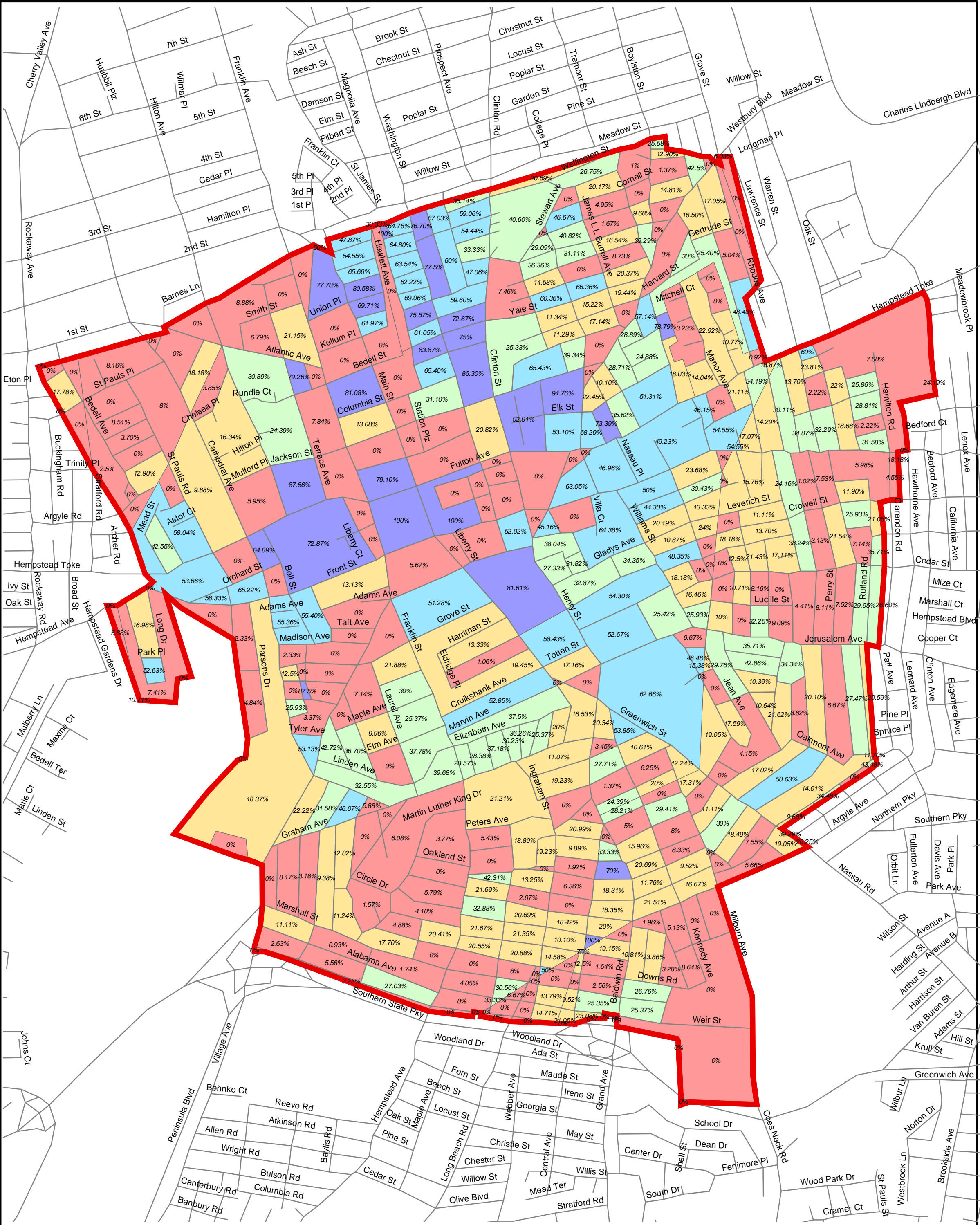

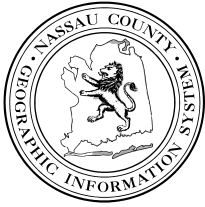
HISPANIC/LATINO POPULATION

Population by Census Blocks

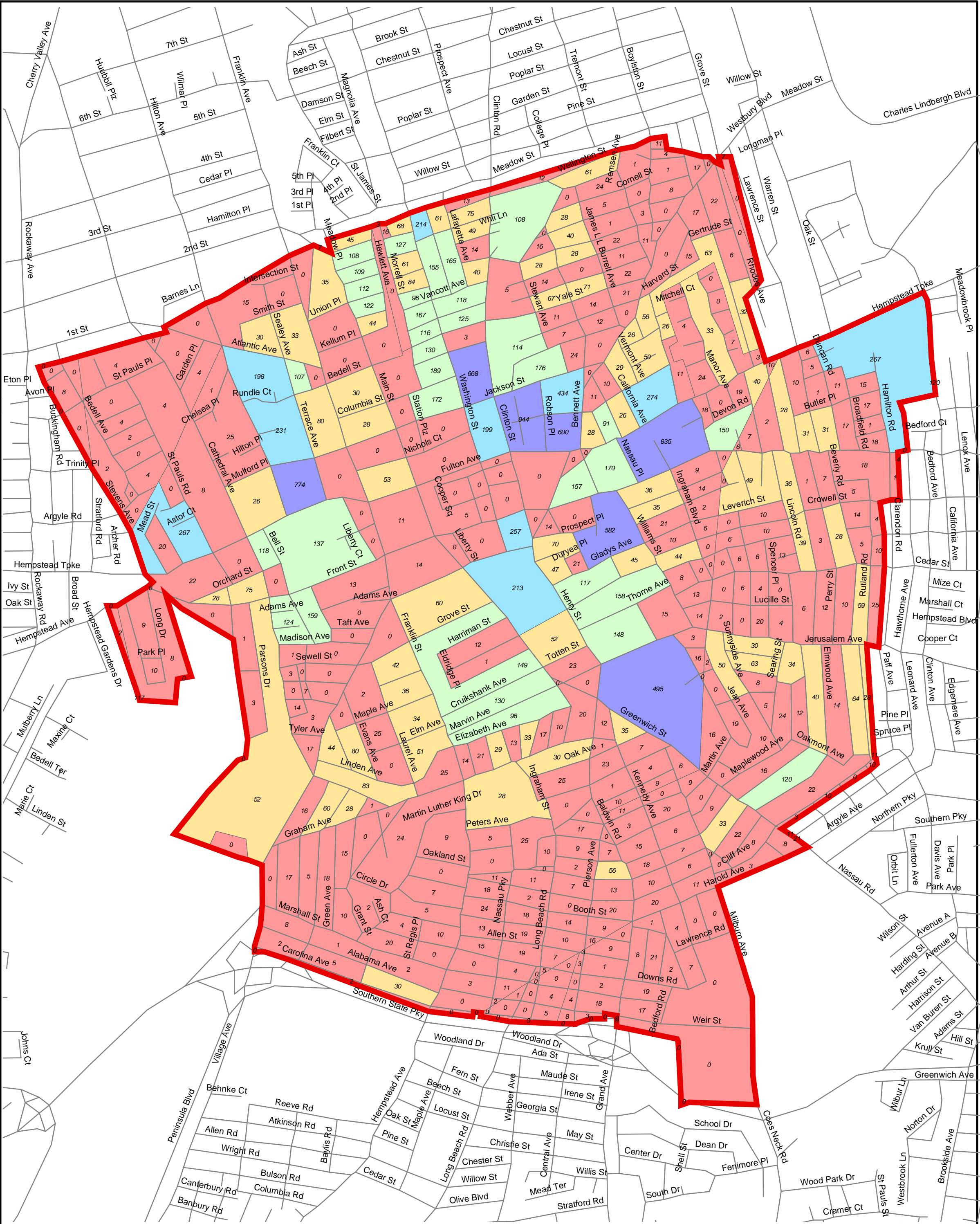
