

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 26-2020

AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION DECLARING AN EMERGENCY FOR IMMEDIATE ACTION UPON A RESOLUTION TO CEREMONIALLY DESIGNATE A PORTION OF THE COUNTY ROAD KNOWN AS COVERT AVENUE FROM THE INTERSECTION OF FIRST AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION OF FIFTH AVENUE TO BE KNOWN AS "EX-CAPTAIN MARK FARINA WAY", AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO INSTALL CONSPICUOUS SIGNAGE ALONG SAID ROADWAY

WHEREAS, the Honorable Richard Nicoello, Presiding Officer, has submitted to this County Legislature a written recommendation dated October 26, 2020, pursuant to the provisions of the County Government Law of Nassau County; and

WHEREAS, the said recommendation refers to an emergency resolution declaring an emergency for immediate action upon a Resolution to ceremonially designate a portion of the County road known as Covert Avenue from the intersection of First Avenue to the intersection of Fifth Avenue to be known as "Ex-Captain Mark Farina Way", and directing the Department of Public Works to install conspicuous signage along said roadway; and

WHEREAS, the said recommendation is that the County Legislature adopt a resolution declaring that an emergency exists in Nassau County the nature of which is to take immediate action upon the aforesaid Resolution; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the County Legislature hereby declares that an emergency exists within Nassau County, the nature of which is to consider and to take immediate action upon the aforesaid Resolution now before this Legislature.
