2 LEGISLATOR KENNEDY: Call the
3 Public Works Committee to order. I will ask
4 the clerk call the roll please.

5 MR. PULITZER: Thank you. Public
6 Works Committee roll call. Legislator Carrie
7 Solages. Legislator Solages? Legislator
8 Arnold Drucker.

9 LEGISLATOR DRUCKER: Here.

10 MR. PULITZER: Ranking Member
11 Siela Bynoe.

12 LEGISLATOR BYNOE: Here.

13 MR. PULITZER: Legislator James
14 Kennedy.

7 MR. PULITZER: Thank you very
8 much Legislator Kennedy.

9 LEGISLATOR KENNEDY: There are
10 eight items on the agenda today which are
11 clerk items 299-20 through 305-20 and 309-20.
12 Clerk item numbers 299-20 through 305-20 are
13 capital budget items and we are going to be
14 teeing them up. There will be a hearing of
15 the full legislature on December 14th.

16 299-20 is a resolution declaring a
17 capital budget emergency pursuant to Section
18 310 of the county government law of Nassau
19 County.

20 Clerk item 300-20 is a bond
21 ordinance providing for a capital expenditure
22 to finance the capital projects identified
23 herein within the county of Nassau and
24 authorizing \$23,178,000 of bonds of the county
25 of Nassau to finance such expenditure pursuant

2 to the local finance law of New York and the
3 county government law of Nassau County.

4 Clerk item 301-20 is an ordinance
5 to amend Ordinance 174-2018 as amended,
6 adopting the capital budget for the county of
7 Nassau for the first year of the four-year
8 capital plan to commence on January 1, 2019,
9 pursuant to the provisions of Section 310 of
10 the county government law of Nassau County.

11 Clerk item 302-20 is a resolutions
12 to adopt a four-year capital plan for the
13 county of Nassau to commence on January 1,
14 2020 pursuant to the provisions of Section 310
15 of the county government law of Nassau County.

16 Clerk item 303-20 is an ordinance
17 to adopt a capital budget for the county of
18 Nassau for the first year of the four-year
19 capital plan to commence on January 1, 2020
20 pursuant to the provisions of Section 310 of
21 the county government law of Nassau County.

22 Clerk item 304-20, a resolution to
23 adopt a four-year capital plan for the county
24 of Nassau to commence on January 1, 2021
25 pursuant to the provisions of Section 310 of

24 execute the agreement on behalf of the county
25 with the New York State Department of

9 MR. ARNOLD: Ken Arnold, Public
10 Works. How are you? This item is a master
11 agreement with New York State DOT for pass
12 through of federal funds. This is associated
13 with our pavement marking work. This is 80
14 percent reimbursement for the work. It's
15 \$800,000, over a \$1 million worth of work.

16 LEGISLATOR KENNEDY: Any debate
17 or discussion? Any public comment? All those
18 in favor of passing this item please signify
19 by saying aye. Any opposed? The item passes
20 unanimously.

22 the committee. May I have a motion to
