LEGISLATOR WALKER: Call the
Health and Social Services Committee to order and I will ask the clerk to take the roll. MR. PULITZER: Thank you madam
chairwoman. Health and Social Services Committee roll call. Legislator Joshua Lafazan.

LEGISLATOR WALKER: Thank you. There are four items on the agenda. Clerk items 318-20, 330-20, 331-20 and 340-20.

Clerk item 318-20 is an ordinance
supplemental to the annual appropriation ordinance in connection with Social Services.

Items 330-20 and 331-20 are ordinances supplemental to the annual appropriations ordinance in connection with the Department of Health.

And 340-20 is an ordinance supplemental to the annual appropriation ordinance in connection with Human Services.

May I have a motion please. By
Legislator Kennedy. Seconded by Legislator Drucker. So the items are before us. And we have for clerk item 318-20.

MR. ROACH: Brendan Roach, social Services. 318-20 is our 100 percent funded

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physicians grant for 2021. It funds DSS
employees who are in Medicaid employment, HEAP and the SNAP units. 100 percent reimbursed by the federal and state governments.

LEGISLATOR WALKER: Do any of the
legislators have any questions? Legislator Drucker.

LEGISLATOR DRUCKER: Thank you madam chairwoman. How are you? Does the Department of Health interact with CPS and DSS regarding suspected child abuse fatalities?

MR. ROACH: I believe they do. I'd have to ask our CPS director. This grant does not cover CPS.

LEGISLATOR DRUCKER: I understand. Can you get back to us on that?

MR. ROACH: Sure.
LEGISLATOR WALKER: Any other questions or comments from the legislature? Any public comment? Hearing none, do we have someone from the administration to speak on items 330-20 and 331-20?

MS. LAURAIN: Good afternoon. Mary Ellen Laurain, Department of Health.

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Item 330-20 is a supplemental appropriation in the amount of $\$ 70,000$. It's for our child fatality review team. This is 100 percent funded through New York State Office of Children and Family Services. This team reviews all deaths of children who reside and died in Nassau County where it was unexplained or unexpected.

LEGISLATOR WALKER: Does that answer your question Legislator Drucker?

LEGISLATOR DRUCKER: Thank you
madam chair. I think that question was really
more pertaining to this item anyway. Yes, that does answer. They do interact with each other with respect to child abuse fatalities? All the different departments?

MS. LAURAIN: Yes. There are different departments on the team, yes. Is that what you asked?

LEGISLATOR DRUCKER: Yes.
MS. LAURAIN: Yes.
LEGISLATOR DRUCKER: Thank you.
LEGISLATOR WALKER: Thank you.
Are there any other questions from the

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legislators regarding item 330-20? We'll move on to --

MS. LAURAIN: Item 331-20 is a
supplemental appropriation in the amount of $\$ 145,955$. This is for the drinking water enhancement program funded through the New York Department of Health. This program assures that the 46 water districts adhere to part five of the New York State Sanitary Code and the Nassau County public health ordinance. The program collects and reviews drinking water samples, inspects, enforces and reviews engineering plans for the water systems in Nassau County.

LEGISLATOR WALKER: Thank you. I
know that job alone keeps your health department very, very busy. MS. LAURAIN: It's a big program. LEGISLATOR WALKER: Are there any other legislators that have any questions or comments? Legislator DeRiggi-Whitton. LEGISLATOR DERIGGI-WHITTON:

Thank you. Is this also going to cover the

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checking for the pea pods and 1,4-dioxine?
MS. LAURAIN: Yes. That was
implemented in all this by the state.
LEGISLATOR WALKER: Any other
legislators have any questions? Any public comment? Thank you.

MS. LAURAIN: Thank you.
LEGISLATOR WALKER: And again,
thank you again for all you've done during this crazy time of COVID that we're all in.

Clerk item 340-20. Anyone here
from the administration for that?
MR. HALL: Brian Hall from Human
Services. This supplemental is from New York State Department of Mental Health. It's for $\$ 375,000$. It's 100 percent reimbursable from the state and it's to be used for the children's side of mental health.

LEGISLATOR WALKER: Any questions
from any of the legislators? Any public
comment? Thank you. Hearing none, thank you
very much. All those in favor of passing
these four items signify by saying aye. Any opposed? These item pass unanimously.
