## LOCAL LAW NO. 9 - 2015

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND THE NASSAU COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE
IN RELATION TO THE VERIFICATION OF SECTION, BLOCK, AND LOT
INFORMATION IN INSTRUMENTS PRESENTED FOR RECORDING



Passed by the Nassau County Legislure on November 23, 2015 Voting: ayes:18, nayes: 1, abstain: 0 Became a law on November 30, 2015 with the approval of the County Executive.

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Nassau as follows:

Section 1. Section 6-33.0 of the Nassau County Administrative Code is amended to read as follows:

- § 6-33.0 Verification of Section, Block, and Lot Information. The Assessor shall be entitled to a fee of two hundred and twenty-five dollars for the verification of the section, block and lot information contained in any deeds, mortgages or satisfactions, or any modifications or consolidations of the foregoing, presented for recording pursuant to Title A of Chapter 19 of this Code.
- § 2. It is hereby determined, pursuant to the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act, 8 N.Y.E.C.L. section 0101 et seq. and its implementing regulations, Part

617 of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and Section 1611 of the County Government Law of Nassau County, that the adoption of this ordinance is a "Type II" Action within the meaning of Section 617.5(c)(20) and (27) of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and, accordingly, is of a class of actions which do not have a significant effect on the environment; and no further review is required.

§ 3. This local law shall take effect immediately.
