<u>Withdrawal/Relief</u>: Situation where the complainant wishes to withdraw without relief or there is relief granted following a resolution between the parties.

<u>No Probable Cause</u>: Although there may have been an action taken that appears to be discriminatory under the Fair Housing Law, the investigation establishes that there is insufficient evidence to prove the action was in fact discriminatory, or in other words, one of "Probable Cause" to transfer to the U.S. DOJ, District Judge, HUD Administrative Law Judge, the New York State Division of Human Rights or a Nassau County Administrative Law judge for a determination.

<u>Probable Cause</u>: As a result of investigation, that may also be considered in a conciliation or other attempted resolution action, there is sufficient evidence or "Probable Cause" to present the case to the (DOJ) District Judge or the HUD (ALI), for a judicial ruling.
