 - Provide a framework for evaluating new services for implementation

- Increase mobility for historically underserved communities and those that must rely on public transportation
- Improve connectivity to employment, education, healthcare, recreation, and downtown areas
- Incorporate cost-effective, proven and emerging technologies used in comparable municipalities
- Implement pilot project(s) over the course of this initiative

- Better understand the County's existing travel patterns and evolving preferences and demands
- Explore public and/or private management models for implementing mobility services
