Closed the Living Wage Loophole



>\$270,000

In the last two years, more than \$270,000 was identified in unpaid wages and time off for 219 workers

2019 KEY FACTS

- ldentified underpaid wages and uncompensated time off worth more than \$56,000 affecting 72 employees.
- Closed the Living Wage Loophole by allowing the County to review the parent and subsidiary of a vendor who has applied for a waiver to the Living Wage Law to ensure that no contractor can skirt the Living Wage Law.
- Through Living Wage audits, identified a number of compliance issues, including employees being paid "off the books" in cash, instances of employees working over 80 hours a week, potentially impacting patient care, an agency failing to properly screen employees by the NYS Criminal Justice Service Sex Offender Registry, and diversion of over \$387,000 in funds, which was reported to law enforcement.
- Fielded a 25 percent increase in the number of calls to the bilingual Living Wage Hotline (516-571-Wage).
