Naloxone/Narcan Training Announcement

Due to the health crisis that began this past March the Nassau County Department of Human Services decided to discontinue in person Narcan Trainings. While this is still in effect, we have developed some alternate options that we would like to share with you.

First, we are providing Narcan trainings virtually for agencies and groups that have a central facility where kits can be distributed from. This includes trainings for people never trained before, as well as, refresher classes. Second, we are aware that people may have a need for replacement kits due to kits expiring or having been used. We recommend that if it is an urgent matter to contact your local pharmacy for quicker access to Narcan. For the other circumstances we will now be providing curbside pick-up from our office in Uniondale and we may also be able to mail kits as needed.

In addition, both our Behavioral Health Helpline (516) 227-TALK (8255) and the Long Island Crisis Center (516) 679-1111 have similar information on how other certified Narcan training providers are distributing and conducting trainings.
